- Works to improve prevention and management of diabetes in Mali, Burkina Faso and Senegal
- **Project results in Mali**
- North Mali: 14 diabetes clinics made functional again after looting and fighting.
- 14 new clinics to be established
- South Mali: 6 additional clinics to be strengthened
- Training of health care personnel / diabetes instructors form an integral part of the project.
- In 2012, “Life For A Child” was asked to support children with type 1 diabetes in Mali with insulin, syringes etc.

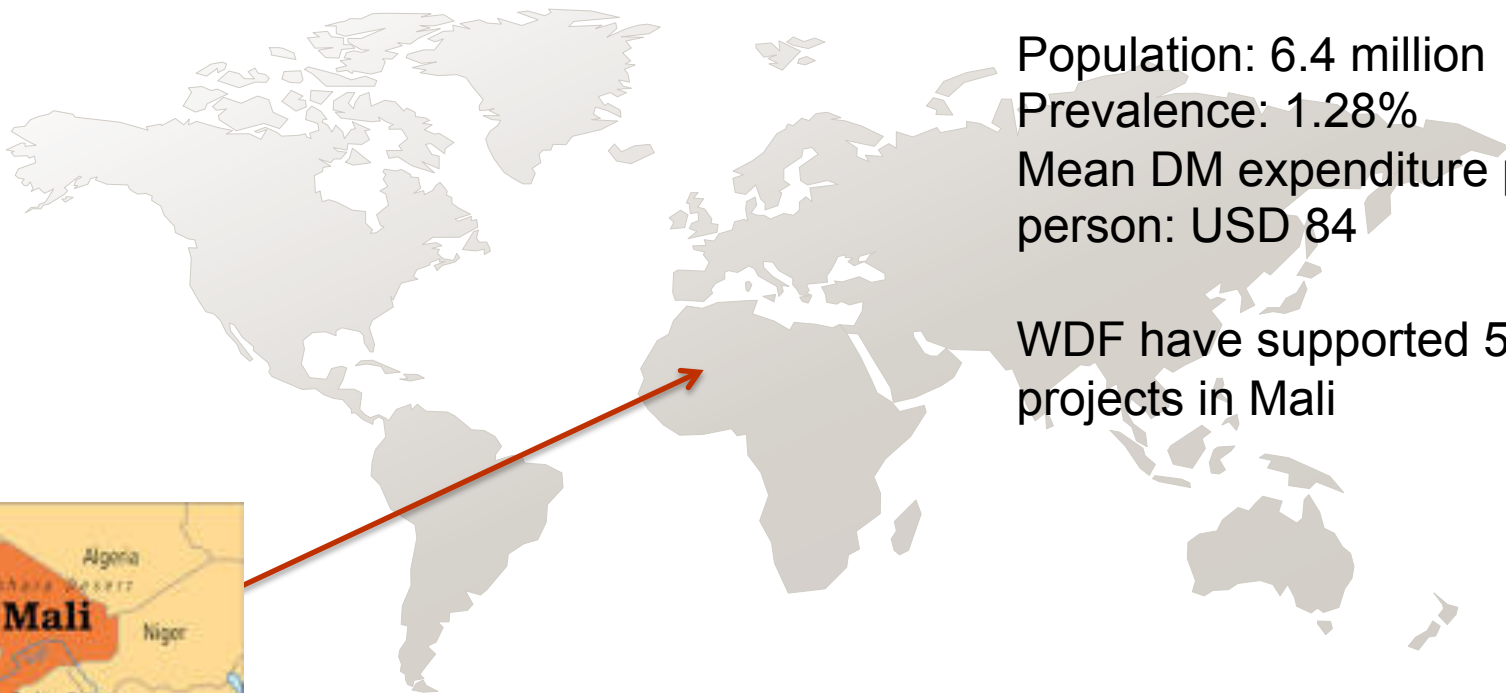


CHILDREN IN MALI

- A 2012 analysis showed that the work done in recent years has helped save many children with diabetes. They now live with their condition.
- A few years ago, only 10 children were kept alive with type 1 diabetes.
- Today, the number has risen to 225 children and the cohort increases every day.
- These 225 children are managed in different regions of Mali



MALI – A WEST AFRICAN COUNTRY



Population: 6.4 million

Prevalence: 1.28%

Mean DM expenditure per person: USD 84

BRINGING CARE TO THE CHILDREN

Objectives:

Strengthen the management of children with type 1 diabetes by organising therapeutic education

Activities:

Refurbish and equip existing facility in a hospital in Mali to function as clinic for children living with type 1 diabetes (225 children)

Organise educational camps (colony) for children and adolescents with type 1 diabetes.

Organise parent-child educational seminar for parents with a young child living with type diabetes.

Strengthen the management of children and adolescents with type 1 diabetes by organising and replicating CDIC tools



ESTIMATED BUDGET (USD)

The funds raised will be earmarked to pay for:

Colony and other education camps	20,000
Adaptation and replication of educational tools	10,000
Renovation of the building	15,000
Support to patient association	5,000
<u>Administrative cost</u>	<u>5,000</u>
Total amount needed (USD)	55,000

With possibility to scale up the number of activities (camps) according to raised funds and needs.



PLANNING

The fundraising project is tentatively planned to begin **February 2015** by:

- Inaugurating the refurbished children's clinic
- Conducting the first educational camps
